- A short statement (100 words or less) of your financial need.
- A letter of recommendation from a high school or college faculty member or military supervisor indicating your general character qualities.
- A recent picture of yourself suitable for publicity if you are a scholarship recipient.
- Any other information you feel might be important to the scholarship selection committee as they consider your application.
